1. Electricity will be provided.
2. It is OK to have a video showing but no loud sound or music or loudspeakers will be permitted
3. Please keep in mind that this is a family oriented event. Many young children will attend. No gory, horrifying, sexually provocative, or shocking photos or displays will be permitted.
4. You may sell T-shirts or other small items with your organizations name on them, or give them away but no other sales of merchandise will be permitted.
5. Please note that this is a Human Rights Event and that tables are to concern human rights
6. This event is open to all faiths. Religious organizations are invited to display their social betterment work. This is however a secular event and is not a platform to disseminate religion per se.
7. The tables provided will be 8' long. If you wish to erect tents they must be under 12' in all dimensions. (This is a park rule.)
8. Please be sure to help clean up your area after the event. This event is completely put on by volunteers. Your help is sincerely appreciated.
